The members of BOS met on 27th September 2023 at Department of Economics under the chairmanship of Smt.T.ADILAKSHMI, lecturer & in charge of department of Economics. The members discussed and resolved the following.

RESOLUTIONS

1. It is unanimously resolved to adopt CBCS for all I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII and VIII End semesters.
2. It is also resolved to approve and introduce Major and Minor subjects syllabi and model question papers for 2023-24 admitted batches with 60 marks for end semester examinations and 40 marks for mid semester examinations.
3. It is discussed the need for introducing few concepts in the Micro Economics in semester 2 and hence resolved to add the Determinants and measurement of elasticity of demand and Consumer surplus in this course of study.
4. It is resolved to approve the syllabi and model questions papers for 2021-22, 2022-23 admitted batches with 75, 60 marks for end semester and 25, 40 marks for internal examinations respectively..

8. It is also resolved to approve and ratify the Life Skill and Skill Development Courses for 2021-22 and 2022-23 admitted batches for all semesters.
9. It is also resolved to approve and ratify the Life Skill, Skill Development Courses 50 marks pattern for all semesters with 2hour duration.
10. It is also resolved to approve the list of examiners and paper setters in the subject.

13. It is discussed the importance of usage of ICT in classroom for effective teaching and hence resolved to approve and implement ICT based teaching –learning techniques.
14. It is discussed the importance of student centric activities to enlighten and improve their learning ability and resolved to approve the student centric activities like seminars, assignments, workshops, field trips and etc.
15. It is also discussed the importance of all round development of the students and hence resolved to encourage them to join in activities like JKC, NSS, Red Ribbon club and other extension activities.
16. It is unanimously resolved to approve and ratify Community Service Projects after 2nd semester, short term internships after 4th semester and long term internships in VI semesters for all admitted batches..
17. It is also resolved to approve and ratify the Certificate Courses in YOGA and Concepts of Banking and Financial Literacy for all students.

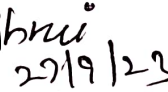

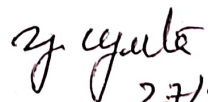
